SUBJECT: The ability to trim internal drive lugs from the track if they are not used as drive components

The ability to trim internal drive lugs from the track if they are not used as drive components,

The official answer is No, no cutting or trimming of the track is allowed on any surface of the track, drive side or track contact side.

Trimming excess rubber that is squeezed out from the application of the track clip to install a stud plate is legal

General Rules TRACK & TRACTION

1. Track dimension rules are specified in each chapter. A 1/8 inch maximum variance in the minimum track width requirement is allowed. No cutting, notching or trimming of the track is allowed, except as noted in specific sections.

OVAL SPRINT COMPETITION Champ class rules TRACK & TRACTION

1. No cleated tracks allowed. Track must be commercially available, one-piece, molded rubber track. Track must be used as produced by the molder of the track. No modification allowed unless specified.
2. Minimum width is 13.5 inches. Minimum length of track is 103 inches. Minimum lug height is ½ inch.
3. Track must be "R" rated from the molder. It is recommended that the track be no more than 3 years old.
