SUBJECT: Sportsman 600 Suspension Rules Update:

From time to time rule changes are submitted, go through the approval process, and later in practical application, issues are found that affect safety or construction integrity.

Sportsman 600 recently was involved in one of these situations.

A rule designed to return front suspensions to a more "original" or "stock" format was implemented. However, in application it was found certain model and brand sleds had structural integrity problems that prohibited them from complying to the rule in a safe manner.

Thus after request from drivers involved with these particular units, and consultation between affected organizations, an update and clarification was made and implemented.

This practice is only used to alleviate a "safety" or structural integrity issue.

Any other changes requested or discussed that are purely individual needs or performance enhancements must be submitted for the spring rules sessions before they will be reviewed. Some classes are froze, and requests for review will not be allowed until the review process is open for that particular class.
