SUBJECT: V-Force/Moto Tassinari Pro Lite Ski Suspension and Steering Omission:

When the 2016 ISR rules were published an omission causing several different variations of a rule interpretation. When the allowance of the "wide" ski with a moveable adjustable keel was included in V-Force Pro Lite rules for 2016 it was not intended to eliminate the existing ski's allowable for the class (Wahl 03-069).

The correction supplied below will be the proper verbiage for the class ski usage.

SKI & SKI RUNNERS

1. Left ski may be a Wahl Bros. brand "wide" ski Wahl Bros part number 03-069 or may be a wide bottom flat ski, with an adjustable, (non cutting, non carbide wear edge) which can be placed anywhere on the ski blank. This wide flat bottom ski may be of any commercial brand or constructed by the chassis builder. The intent of this ski and its placement is to limit the aggressiveness of the ski assembly for steering purposes. Custom built skis that do not meet the criteria or are an attempt to increase the aggressiveness of the ski performance will be reviewed for acceptance on a ski by ski basis.
2. The left ski may not have more than 8 inches of carbide cutting edge.
3. Right ski may be of any design as long as it meets current ISR standards and description in General Rules
